The following is a list of items to bring to your exam.

- FRN number or Social Security number**
- A photocopy of your current license to send in**
- Any Certificates of Successful Completion of Examination (CSCE) from previous exam sessions.**
- \$15.00 cash or check made out to the ARRL**

The FRN can be used on the paperwork instead of giving out your Social Security Number. If you do not have an FCC issued FRN, I suggest getting one now. <https://fjallfoss.fcc.gov/coresWeb/publicHome.do>
